Choose Life

"I call heaven and earth as witnesses today against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing; therefore choose life, that both you and your descendants may live; that you may love the Lord your God, that you may obey His voice, and that you may cling to Him, for He is your life and the length of your days," Deuteronomy 30:19-20.

For many years my life consisted of heavy drinking and drug use, stealing and rebellion. It was during my rebellion that I met a beautiful young woman and fell in love. Seven months later we got married and four months after that she gave birth to a beautiful baby boy. I was 18 years old and had my own family. Even with a family and responsibilities it wasn't reason enough for me to change my life. After losing my family, job and having numerous run-ins with the law, I quit running from God and sincerely cried out to Him for help. He heard my cry and brought me to Shiloh Ministries. Since being at Shiloh, I have developed a relationship with the Holy Spirit, which nothing in this world can compare. God has opened up my eyes and revealed to me the true meaning of life.
