**Duped to Dope** 

"And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit." Ephesians 5:18

I was in prayer for the content of this months Newsletter and heard the word's "Duped to Dope." The Lord and I do have serious moments, but this phrase was different from any other. It got my attention. I pulled out my dependable Webster Dictionary and looked up the word "dupe" which read, "one that is easily deceived; a fool." I continued in my dialogue with Him about what was on His heart.

There is a considerable level of deception in society, as well as, the Church concerning alcohol, marijuana, pain medications, anti-depressants, etc... notice the word "deception" (the act of deceiving.) This is Satan's greatest strategy against humanity. If a person is deceived, then one can never experience the truth that liberates. **John 8:32** says, "you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." Truth is meant to be experienced. One needs only to observe the past twenty years to see how skillful Satan has been in lulling (causing someone to fall asleep) society and the Church into a pacific state of compromise. My name is Nathan Galvan and since graduating from Shiloh Ministries I have been blessed with a great job, working for a top corporation out of the Woodlands, TX. I had also been serving a 6 year probation since 2010, but was pre-released from that in December, 2014. While at Shiloh I prayed for a family with children. Well the Lord gave me more than I could ever imagine. I was reacquainted with my longtime friend Vania Magallanes, and her daughter, Allesandra, which eventually led to marriage. I fell in Love with both of them right away. Alessandra, has an absent father and I've stepped in to fill that role since she was 5 months old. She is now 2 years old and calls me daddy. She is my little princess. A few months after marriage my wife became pregnant with twins (boy & girl). Our twins were born prematurely on June 1, 2015 and were placed in NICU three days later. My baby girl Milena Denise Galvan seemed to be doing better than my son, Micah Daniel Galvan. The Dr. told me this was normal, that one twin usually stays a little behind, but soon catches up. Well on the fourth morning my wife and I received news that no one was expecting. We were called into NICU to speak with the cardiologist.



He told us that throughout the night they had to increase the oxygen level on my son and were growing curious as to why. They checked his lungs and everything was fine, so the cardiologist ran more tests and what he found was alarming. My son had TAPVR, which meant his pulmonary vein wasn't connecting to the left side of his heart, and in turn, wasn't getting oxygenated blood from left side of his heart into the rest of his body. My wife and I feared the worst, which allowed anxiety to grip my heart. The cardiologist told us that he would need heart surgery and would be flown to San Antonio Children's Methodist Hospital. When I got in the car to pack for the trip I lost control and cried out to the Lord, "Please do not allow the devil to take my baby boy!" The Holy Spirit began to minister to my heart. He reminded me of Abraham, who offered his son Isaac as a sacrifice, and as hard as it seemed, that is exactly what I did. I placed my baby boy at the altar of God and declared, "the child is Yours God!" I thanked Him for entrusting me to be his earthly father and simply worshiped Him the whole way to San Antonio. My wife and I stood on God's promises and played worship music. We read the bible and prayed for our son, before and after surgery. My son had the surgery and it was a complete success. Ten days after the surgery, on Father's Day, my son was released from the hospital and we were all reunited. Words cannot describe what the entire family went through, but we all had the prince of peace, "King Jesus" with us the entire time. It is God and God alone that receives our praise, and glory for what He has done in my son, Micah. What the enemy meant for harm, God has turned around and used for His glory and honor. We are now a happy family of 5, and I can truly say that if I had not gone to Shiloh Ministries I would not have been prepared spiritually for that battle. I would not have been strong enough had it not been for my transformation. I am forever grateful to God, and to Pastor Rocky and Sister Debbie for their obedience to the calling which God has specifically placed on their lives.
