

As a born again believer have you ever felt dis-connected from your Life Source (*God the Father*)? I have. Of course I'm speaking of the devil being identified by the Apostle Paul as the god of this world (*2Cor. 4:4*). He is the dark and negative source of influence on this present culture.

What is culture anyway? Culture is defined as; "the behaviors and beliefs characteristic of a particular social, ethnic, or age groups." Our Society is made up of many different idiosyncrasy's (*mannerism or costumes). It is here where satan exploits and devises a scheme to manipulate (*to influence skillfully in an unfair manner) society. What does the fruit of his manipulation produce? 
