

"Then he breathed on them and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit," John 20:22

When Holy Spirit invites us into a relationship, it surpasses any invitation we have ever known, and goes far beyond any that our mind can desire or comprehend. HE is such a giver. However, Holy Spirit is the most misunderstood, unrecognized, and neglected of The Godhead, even though HE is our starting point with HIS beckoning, brooding, initiated invitation to come, for no one can come to Jesus unless first The Holy Spirit draws (John 6:44).

Hi, my name is Justin Abbie, I am 33 years of age and my wife and I live in Dayton, Texas. I had a great family growing up and I was raised in a good, loving home. I also brought home straight "A" report cards and seldom had any lower. But at the age of 8, fear and anger gripped me as I started having social anxieties and I started battling those fears by escaping into my studies, which further distanced me from people. In my early teens I started smoking pot just to try to fit in. By the time I was 16, I was suspended from school and had some legal problems due to drugs. When my family moved from Dayton to the Houston area, I started using a lot of hardcore drugs and also started selling them to support my habit. By the age of 19, I had become a hardcore addict. After a short prison term, I stopped selling drugs but continued using drugs for many years, always trying to fill a void. I had trouble keeping a job, due to my addiction, which fueled my fear and anger. At the age of 30, after going to jail 9 times and being involved in 9 car wrecks, I went back to college for the third time. By the Grace of God, I completed college and met my beautiful wife, Katie. We married but shortly afterwards my addiction spiraled downward out of control. Praise the Lord Jesus Christ for Shiloh Ministries, where I got saved and baptized in the Holy Spirit. It is by the Mercy of God I am still here today. At Shiloh, I was able to



encounter The Father Heart of God through The Holy Spirit in such a great way that He delivered me from addiction, hate, fear, anger, and depression. He filled the void that I had with His Love. The Lord has reconciled my marriage with my wife, and we have recently joined Maranatha Church. I love witnessing to people everywhere I go and just showing and spreading the love of Jesus to everyone. I am thankful to all the Supporters of Shiloh and the Staff for their obedience and sacrifices. Most of all I give all Glory and Praise to my Heavenly Father for His Grace, to my Lord Jesus Christ for saving me, and to Holy Spirit, in whose gentle voice always guides my path.
