It is an awesome testimony of people loving God in their giving to see men restored for destinies to be fulfilled in the Kingdom of God. Please know we are grateful to everyone who have sown into this project & also Shiloh's general fund. We invite everyone to come out & take a tour of the Shiloh Campus. 
