And more than ever believers were added to the Lord, multitudes of both men and women, so that they even carried out the sick into the streets and laid them on cots and mats, that as Peter came by at least his shadow might fall on some of them. The people also gathered from the towns around Jerusalem, bringing the sick and those afflicted with unclean spirits, and they were all healed."

These verses reveals what we are to model as believers. The Church in Acts demonstrated an ardent Love for Christ and then the Power of The Holy Ghost was released for the working of miracles. The result of all of these power encounters were people being healed, restored and then added to The Church. I didn't get saved in jail, but a seed was surely planted in that jail, so that doors could open for me to come to Shiloh Ministries. I can see that what I was doing was an abomination to God (Proverbs 6:16-19).



While at Shiloh, my relationship with my family was restored, the bondage of drugs and alcohol addiction broken, and the chains of rebellion have been broken off of my life. I'm not saying that I'm completely restored, but I know that our God is The God that makes me whole. "He who began this good work in me is faithful to complete it," Philippians 1:6.
