Marijuana, cocaine and prescription drugs became just an every day thing for me as long as there was money there was drugs and destruction. I had also began getting into trouble with the law, often being arrested and hauled off to jail not even caring. Life was a big joke to me, completely meaningless. Around age 19 is when reality really set in or so I thought it did. I checked myself into a 30-day drug rehab in the Houston area and that didn't

last long. After failing to rid myself of these addictions yet again in my despair my family assisted me in getting to North Carolina to go to another rehab facility only to let myself and everybody around me down once again, still I was not ready...When I returned back to the Houston area things began to get worse and worse my addictions were out of control, some of my close friends had tragically died and I just could not handle life anymore. This was a vulnerable time in my life when I had first heard about a place here locally called Shiloh Ministries. This place is the best thing that has ever happened to me in my entire life!
